DCMA Approved Purchasing System

Darrah Electric received Defense Contractor Management Agency (DCMA) approval for its purchasing system in accordance with DFARS 252.244-7001.

ITAR Compliant

As a defense services provider, Darrah Electric is International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) compliant and abides by the ITAR as it applies to its United States Munitions List (USML) linked goods or services.



SAM Registered

Darrah Electric is SAM registered on the System for Award Management (SAM). It is a government run site that serves as a central registration point for government contractors.



DDTC Registered

Darrah Electric is DDTC Registered. The Arms Export Control Act requires that all manufacturers, exporters, temporary importers, and brokers of defense articles (including technical data) as defined on the United States Munitions List (ITAR part 121) and furnishers of defense services are required to register with the Directorate of Defense Trade Controls (DDTC) as described in ITAR part 122 (part 129 for brokers).



Gidep member

Darrah is an active GIDEP member. GIDEP is a cooperative activity between government and industry participants seeking to reduce or eliminate expenditures of resources by sharing technical information. Since 1959, over \$2.1 BILLION in prevention of unplanned expenditures has been reported.
